The Rotary Club of Little Rock, also known as Club 99, teamed with the Miracle League to open a new baseball field in the fall of 2006 for children with special needs at the Little Rock Junior Deputy baseball complex in Riverdale.

The Miracle League was formed in 1998 by the Rockdale Baseball Association in Georgia. It allows children with special needs the chance to suit up in uniform, step up to the plate and enjoy baseball in its purest form.

In celebration of Rotary International's Centennial anniversary in 2006, Club 99 began working with local agencies and businesses to build the complex, which will be used by local non-profits serving children and adults with special needs, as well as families in Little Rock and surrounding communities.
